### Kudos Krush €9.50

A lusciously smooth melody of crème de banana, pomegranate-syrup and smirnoff raspberry vodka, shaken with orange juice and fresh single cream, then drained over rocks.

### Totally Bangers €9.50

A zesty creation for the 'sweet-toothed', mixing galliano, peach schnapps, grenadine, smirnoff vodka with iced orange juice.

### Kudos Spritzer €8.50

A vineyard twist on the spritzer using a fusion of dry white wine, wedges of lemon, fresh mint and sugar syrup.

### Kudos Bar-tender's Special €11.00

A well-balanced medley of smirnoff vanilla vodka, tangy triple sec, smooth cocoa kahlua and cream served over ice in a chocolate-rimmed glass.

### Cantonese Delight €9.50

A combination of a passion fruit puree, rum and sweetened milk, shaken with rocks and poured straight up.

### Bali Breeze €11.00

An exotic fruity concoction of cranberry, pineapple and grapefruit juices shaken with a double shot of smirnoff vanilla vodka and set off with a dash of banana liqueur.

### Singapore Slings €11.00

A true classic of cork dry gin, cherry brandy, hennessy cognac, lemon juice and soda.

### China White €11.00

A blend of baileys liqueur, white crème de cacao served with smirnoff vodka.

### Mai Tai €11.00

A no-nonsense classic of white and dark rum, triple sec, grenadine and fresh lime juice served traditionally without ice.

### Japanese Slipper €9.50

A fruity melon pick-me-up with triple sec and lemon juice served with a brandy-macerated cherry.

### Martini €15.00

Four shots of gin or vodka with a smidgen of dry vermouth.

### Cosmopolitan €9.50

A blend of smirnoff citrus vodka, cointreau with fresh lime and lemon juice with a dash of cranberry juice.

# Wines of the World

## White

### Semillon / Sauvignon

Argentina – Astica, 2003

An harmonious blend of fresh fruit flavours and acidity from the Sauvignon balanced by the fullness and length of the Semillon.

### Chardonnay

France – Marquis de Goulaine, 2003

Chardonnay as it should be, crisp and dry with a long fruit after taste.

### Chardonnay

France – Fox Wood, 2003

Pleasant aroma with a high fruit intensity for a medium wine.

### Sauvignon / Semillon

France, Bordeaux – Haut.Rian, 2003

Grassy and gooseberryish in style offering crisp lively drinking at an excellent price.

### Picpoul de Pinet

France – Felines Jourdan, 2003

Ripe pear aromas with honey hints. Perfect with shellfish or seafood.

### Pinot Grigio

Italy – Fattori, 2003

Aromas of marzipan, lychees and lemondrops, nougat and almond with a lemon tang.

### Sauvignon Blanc

Chile – J. Bouchon, 2004

An elegant wine, fresh on the palate, with good acidity.

### Sauvignon Blanc Semillon

Australia – Four Sister, 2003

Up-front flavours of pineapple and lemon curd.

### Gavi di Gavi Ca da Bosio

Italy – Terredavino, 2003

Pure Cortese grapes round fresh and forward. A lovely aperitif well worth a revisit.

### Sauvignon Blanc

New Zealand – Glazebrook, 2003

Dry, crisp Sauvignon Blanc with a tropical finish.

### Chardonnay

California – Clos du Bois, 2002

Rich and buttery with a light vanilla oak flavour.

### Chablis

France – Domaine Seguinot B., 2003

A classic wine for drinking any time, crisp and clean with a subtle finish.

### Sancerre

France – Dom. Vincent Grall Le Manoir, 2003

A crisp refreshing wine with citrus flavours with a well rounded finish.

### Chenin Blanc

Australia – Coriole Diva, 2004

Lime and citrus flavours with a touch of mineraliness and clean dry finish.

## Red

### Syrah

France – Fox Wood, 2003

Rich, ripe fruit laced with spice and well integrated with French oak.

### Merlot

Maule Valley, Chile – J Bouchon, 2003

Flavours of ripe red fruits with mocha hints, soft tannins and a long finish.

### Nero d'Avola

Sicilia, Italy – P. Bidini I.G.T 2003

A lovely combination of herbs and cherry fruit flavours.

### Dolcetto

Italy – D'Alba, Roccabella DOC, 2002

This Dolcetto is cultivated in the historcial vineyards of Tanaro region to inspire a truly classical Italian wine.

### Cabernet Franc

France – De Luc Lapeyre, 2001

A rich full bodied wine with plummy spicy fruit.

### Shiraz

Australia – Four Sister, 2002

Ample, dark fruit flavours are lifted by a refreshing tang and pepper-dusted finish.

### Petit Chateau Sissan

France – Grand Reserve, 2001

A well balanced nose with some spicy, woody and fruity notes and full-bodied, It turns out to be robust and offers some firm tannins.

### Chianti

Italy – Peppoli, 2000

Fragrant wine with well balanced fruit, good structure.

### Fleurie

France – Joseph Drouhin, 2003

Good deep ruby in colour, crushed berries and ripe cherries on the palate.

### Organic Rioja

Spain – Bagordi Crianza, 1999

An organic wine, using a balance of modern winemaking & skilled viticulture.

### Cotes du Rhone

France – Rasteau. Dom, Charavin, 2003

Bursting with soicy red fruits on the noise with a soft mouth feel.

### Puisseguin

France – St Emilion, 2001

Ripe sweet merlot fruit with a super balance.

### Cabernet / Shiraz / Merlot

Australia – Skuttlebutt, 2002

Spice, chocolate and red fruit aromas become wild berry fruits with vanilla hints.

### Pinotage

S.Africa – Old Bush, Warwick Est., 1999

Full bodied with a strong end, well balanced oaky flavour.
